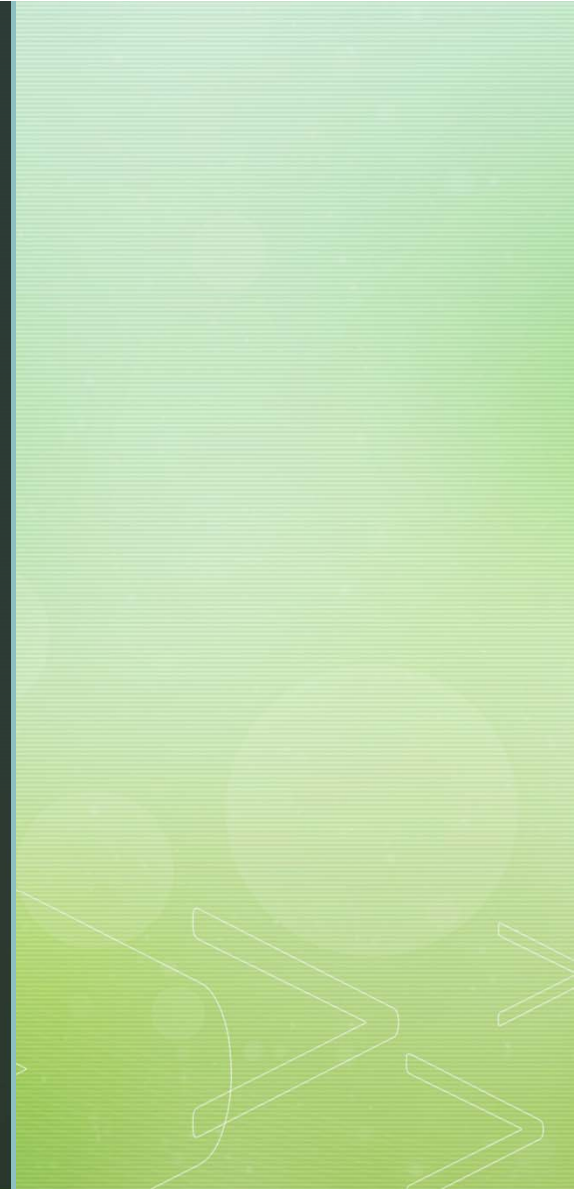


HOW TO CONDUCT A BIBLE STUDY
